



## Tower of Toys aims to help hundreds of New Hampshire families

**MANCHESTER, N.H.** — A tower made of toys is taking shape in downtown Manchester.

This is the 10th year that New Hampshire companies have teamed up to build the [Tower of Toys](#), which are then distributed to families to put under their Christmas trees.

"The first year was small, maybe a mound," said Amanda Wihby, co-owner and COO of the Red Arrow Diner. "And now, we literally fill two floors of toys. And last year, we gave toys to 1,500 kids."
