**MANCHESTER, N.H.** — A Manchester organization is helping to provide families and children with toys and essential items this holiday season.

**Tower of Toys** is in its 12th year.

They collect unwrapped children's toys, sports equipment, art supplies, cosmetics, movie certificates and gift cards and then distribute them to families.

The collections make a tower shape in the atrium of the Beacon Building on Elm Street.

So far this year, they have helped over 120 families.

“We try to make it as easy for these families because, you know, sometimes it’s not easy to ask for help. So we try to eliminate that, you know, obviously no judgment, no applications, nothing,” Kenny Craig, Tower of Toys board member, said.

You can drop off any donations to the Beacon Building anytime until Dec. 14.

They are also holding a Dine Out for Charity event on Dec. 9 where the proceeds at select Manchester restaurants go directly to the organization.
